Performers x2 Lenny/Narrator Walter

**Props** 

May be as simple as two chairs and a laptop.

Narrator. "Lenny and Walter, are the two Angels who run the Archive section of the Heavenly Office, cataloguing a copy of every Book, Video, Photograph, Letter, email, and other Document on earth, for the Judgement."

(Narrator walks off, and Walter walks on and sits at his desk, then Lenny walks on whistling merrily).

Walter. "What are you smiling about?...Oh no!...You've been in there again haven't you?"

Lenny. (Innocently). "In where?"

Walter. "You know where...out of bounds!...Into the Famous Moments building?"

Lenny. "Funny you should say that...I've got something to show you...a video...I think you'll find it very interesting!"

Walter. "At least they didn't have a search party out looking for you this time..."

Lenny. "Some things in life are worth the effort!"

Walter. "Yes...especially when the effort doesn't involve any kind of work..."

Lenny. "Walter...may I call you Walt, my friend?"

Walter. "No, you may not!"

Lenny. "Okay...Walter...Have you ever heard of Cuba?"

Walter, "No...should I?"

Lenny. "Not really...it's famous for cigars...that give people cancer of the mouth and throat..."

Walter. "And that made it famous?"

Lenny. "No...It was two people who got control of the country, through lies and deceit...and destroyed it...who made it famous!"

Walter. "Just two people?...Out of the whole population?"

Lenny. "Yes...it's the usual story...Socialist nightmares always begin with one person, a bully who wants to have power...not just *some* power...but *complete* power...I saw it in a smaller country a couple of years ago...A Communist woman got control...and the place was bankrupted...and became a nightmare."
