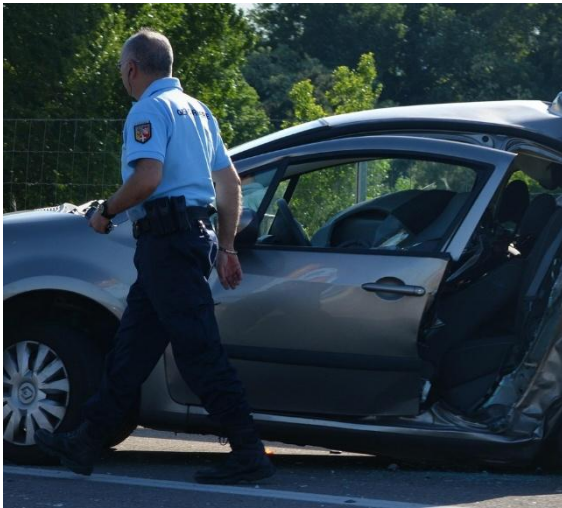

The public are bombarded with campaigns against drink driving and warned of the consequences if they are caught, and yet people are continually caught 'over the limit.'

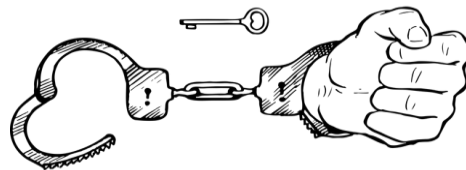


Don't they believe what they hear? Yes, of course they do, but they still think they can get away with it, and how the excuses pour out when they are caught.

St Paul reminds us in Hebrews 9:27, *'It is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgement.'*

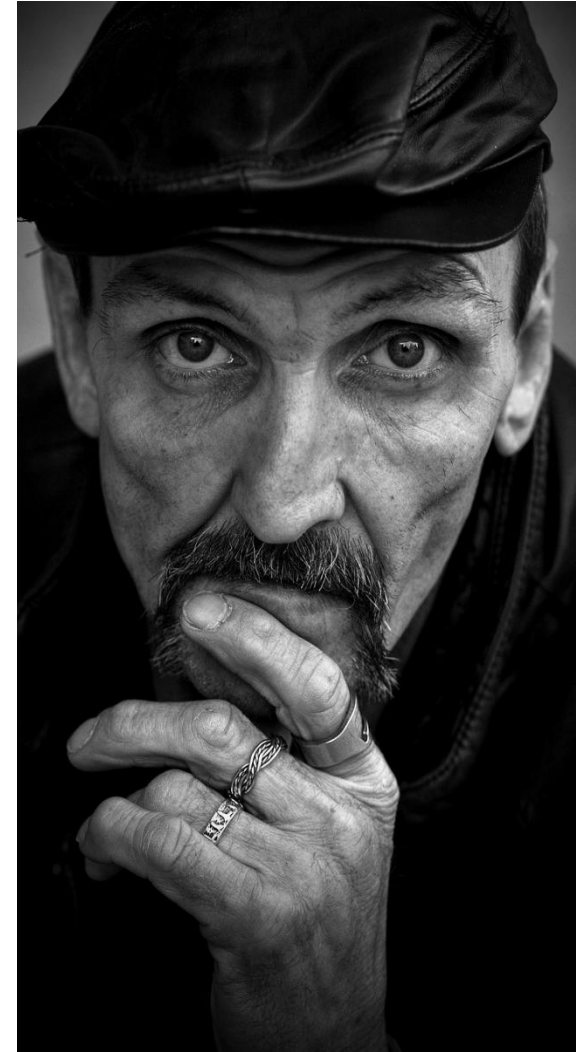
